Our third Ranch Riding clinic was well attended with twelve riders eager to learn and potentially show their horses. Nine riders nominated for the Beginner Ranch Riding class in the March Madness show to practice what they had learnt earlier in the day. Ranch Riding Rules

In a ranch riding class, the horse is shown individually in pattern work and is judged on the precision of the pattern manoeuvres and the horse's movements.

In all gaits, movement of the ranch riding horse should simulate a horse needing to cover long distances, softly and quietly, like that of a working ranch horse.

Walk-The walk is a natural, flat footed, four-beat gait. The gait is rhythmic and ground-covering. As in all gaits, the horse should display a level, or slightly above level topline with a bright, attentive expression.

Trot- The trot is a natural two-beat gait demonstrating more forward motion than the western jog. **Extended Trot-** The extended trot is an obvious lengthening of the stride with a definite increase in pace. The horse should be moving in a manner as if it were covering a large area on a ranch with an above level topline.

Lope- The lope is a three-beat gait. The lope should be relaxed and smooth with a natural, forward moving stride.

Extended Lope- The extended lope is not a run or a race but should be an obvious lengthening of the stride, demonstrating a forward, working speed. The horse should display an above level topline with a bright, attentive expression

Ranch Riding Apparel and Equipment

No hoof polish.

No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions.

Trimming inside ears is discouraged.

Trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair.

Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit.

Excessive silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.

It is suggested competitors use a breast collar and a rear cinch.

Ranch Riding Penalties

A contestant shall be penalized each time the following occur:

One (1) point penalties

Too slow (per gait)

Over-bridled (per manoeuvre)

Out of frame (per manoeuvre)

Break of gait at walk or trot for 2 strides or less

Three (3) point penalties

Break of gait at walk or trot for more than 2 strides

Break of gait at lope

Wrong lead or out of lead

Draped reins (per manoeuvre)

Out of lead or cross-cantering more than two strides when changing leads

Trotting more than three strides when making a simple lead change

Severe disturbance of any obstacle

Five (5) point penalties

Blatant disobedience (kick, bite, buck, rear, etc.)

for each refusal

Ten (10) point penalty

Unnatural ranch horse appearance (Horse's tail is obvious and consistently carried in an unnatural manner in every manoeuvre)

(OP) Placed below horses performing all manoeuvres

Eliminates manoeuvre

Incomplete manoeuvre

Zero (0) score

Illegal equipment including – hoof black, braided or banded manes, or tail extensions

Wilful abuse

Major disobedience or schooling

Lameness

No specific penalties will be incurred for nicks/hits on logs but deduction may be made in manoeuvre score

No specific penalties will be incurred for over/ under spins but deduction may be made in manoeuvre score.





2018 Show Information & Conditions

- Nominations to be RECEIVED no later than Monday 9th April 2018.
- Late entries will be accepted by 10 am Saturday morning, all competitors in the Clinic must have entries in before the Clinic.
- For Sanctioned events, owners and riders must be current financial members of the National Reining Horse
 Association. All horses must be licensed with the NRHA. Any transfers of ownership need to be completed
 by the NRHA prior to showing. A copy of horse competition license and NRHA membership card must
 accompany entry form.
- The working order will be drawn and will be as per program with the exception of late entries, which will
 run first.
- All sanctioned classes will be run in accordance with the NRHA Handbook.
- The QRHA will retain 50% of the entry fee including jackpot classes.
- Horses that are entered for both events in concurrent run class will only have one run and the score will count for both events and will therefore only pay one Judges Fee upon nomination.
- By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to
 the terms and conditions as set out. The indemnity and consent form accompanying entry form must be
 completed and signed or entries will not be accepted.
- Management reserves the right to alter this program once final entry numbers are known.
- 12. The Grounds will available to Bump in 12pm Friday 13th April
- DOGS must be kept at campsites. No dogs allowed in grandstand, marshalling area or in vicinity of Canteen. All dog droppings must be picked up, especially in the stable area.
- 14. No smoking in the main arena grandstand. Please use designated smoking areas.
- 15. All competitors riding on the grounds must have saddles and bridle and correct footwear at all times.
- 16. Anyone riding on the grounds regardless of competing must be member of QRHA / Reining Australia.
- 17. Open Pen Friday 4pm to 10 pm Main arena ONLY, any other times can be book with QSEC individually

Event participants are required to make their own on-line booking and payment for stables, and camping sites to Nominate. PLEASE NOTE THESE WILL CLOSE MONDAY 9TH APRIL 8 AM. Note: As per QSEC rules no stables will be available unless prior booking made through Nominate.

QRHA NON SANCTIONED EVENTS – MUST BE A MEMBER OF QRHA OR NRHA

BEGINNER RIDER/HORSE: Restricted to riders who have not won more than 3 Reining events

(sanctioned/non sanctioned) as at 1st January 2018
JUNIOR REINING HORSE: For horses five years & under.

SENIOR REINING HORSE: For horses six years and over.

Western attire and Saddlery not compulsory in these non-sanctioned classes however a long sleeved shirt and hat or helmet required (no caps). Riders may use one or two hands on the reins or change from one handed to two handed throughout the performance. Any <u>legal</u> headgear is allowed.

- ** Limited Non Pro, Limited Open/Rookie Professional will be run concurrently
- Youth 13 and under & Youth 14-18 will be run concurrently
- Rookie Level 1 & Level 2 will be run concurrently
- Non Pro & Prime Time Non Pro will be run concurrently.
- Intermediate Open, Intermediate Non Pro and Open will be run concurrently.
- Novice Horse Open Level 1 & 2— Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 & 2 will be run concurrently Competitors nominating in both events will only pay one judges fee.
