Some information from Reining Australia

The AGM was held on the 8th December at the Gold Coast in Queensland as well as the presentation of the End of Year Awards and Rookie of the Year congratulation to all the recipients, a full list will be posted on the website.

The Treasurer Mick Taylor gave a very comprehensive report on the financial position of Reining Australia which is now in very good shape, with Q12, the National Show and Equitana all making a profit.

The elections of the Board where held and the positions are as follows:

All their contract details are on the website and we encourage members to contact them if they have any enquiries. The Board will be holding a Face to Face Meeting on the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} February 2013.

Please note that there has been a slight change to the date of the Continental Affiliate Championships and Futurity Show to the 25th to 28th September 2013, this has happened because of change in bookings at Aelec.

The Continental Affiliate conditions are on the website, the main points being that Affiliates are required to hold only two (2) NRHA approved shows, and riders must participate in a minimum of one (1) of those Show, and place in the top 20 horse and rider combination of each class they wish to qualify for the Continental Affiliate Championship.

A list of the Top Twenty Highest Horse earnings will also be listed on the website, we would like to Congratulate Whizz Peppy owned by Charles Kalnins for being the first horse in Australia to go over \$60,000

Please also note that that the ineligibility list and End of Year Awards will run from the 1st January of each year as there is a change over period this year two shows from Victoria will be included in t he End of Year Awards for 2013. Riders and Owners must remember that it is their responsibility to know which classes they are eligible to compete in.

Reining Australia is once again running the Green Rider Program; all riders must renew each year and only riders who are not members of Reining Australia need to pay the \$30 fee. We thank the members for support of the program for 2012. Application and updated conditions are on the website.

QRHA NON SANCTIONED EVENTS – MUST BE A MEMBER OF QRHA OR NRHA

BEGINNER RIDER: Restricted to riders who have not won more than 3 Reining events

(sanctioned/non sanctioned) as at 1st January 2013
JUNIOR REINING HORSE: For horses five years & under.
SENIOR REINING HORSE: For horses six years and over.

GREEN HORSE: Restricted to horses that have not won more than 3 Reining events (sanctioned/non sanctioned) as at 1st January 2013.

Western attire and Saddlery not compulsory in these non sanctioned classes however a long sleeved shirt and hat or helmet required (no caps). Riders may use one or two hands on the reins or change from one handed to two handed throughout the performance. Any <u>legal</u> headgear is allowed.

GREEN RIDER

Green Rider Level 1 Open to any rider holding valid RA Green Rider card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points and less than fifty (50) Green Rider points.

Green Rider Level 2 Open to any rider holding valid RA Green Rider card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points and more than 50 points and less than 100 (100) Green points.

Green Rider Level 1 and 2 will be run concurrently

All riders must pay the Annual fee of \$30 to be in the program (unless you are already RA/NRHA Member) Full conditions and application form on the RA website.

Show management cannot charge exhibitors a judge's fee

Show management can retain any percentage of the entry fee

Must use NRHA patterns 1-11. However simple lead changes are allowed and the rider may use one (1) or two (2) hands, but must not change hands or switch from one to two hands.

Show Information & Conditions

Entries will be taken on Saturday morning till 12 noon.

Owners and riders competing in sanctioned events must be current financial members of the National Reining Horse Association and Reining Australia and all horses must be licensed with the NRHA. Any transfers of ownership need to be completed by the NRHA prior to showing. A copy of horse competition license and NRHA membership card must be presented with entry form:

The working order will be drawn and will be as per program with the exception of late entries, which will run first.

DOGS must be kept at campsites. No dogs allowed in grandstand, marshalling area or in vicinity of canteen.

No glass permitted in the Stable Area and No smoking in the Grandstand

By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out. The indemnity and consent form accompanying entry form must be completed and signed or entries will not be accepted.

Management reserves the right to alter this program once final entry numbers are known.

- Limited Open/Rookie Professional will be run concurrently
- Youth 13 and under & Youth 14-18 will be run concurrently
- ** Rookie Level 1 & Level 2 will be run concurrently
- ** Non Pro & Prime Time Non Pro will be run concurrently.
- ** Intermediate Open and Open will be run concurrently.
- Novice Horse Open Level 1 & 2— Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 & 2 will be run concurrently







QUEENSLAND BUCKLE SERIES 2013

RULES:

- Queensland Buckle Series will be conducted under the guidance of both QRHA and SQRHA committees.
- Queensland Buckle Series 2013 will be conducted over the three biggest QLD shows A.
 Derby Shoot Out (QSEC Caboolture); B. Pacific Coast Spectacular (Gatton); C. QLD State Championships (Caboolture)
- Queensland Buckle Series will be in relation to the following events: Novice Horse Non Pro (Level 1); Novice Horse Open (Level 1); Rookie (Level 1); Rookie (Level 2); Limited Non Pro; Intermediate Non Pro; Non Pro; Prime Time Non Pro; Rookie Professional; Limited Open; Intermediate Open; Open; Youth 13 and under; Youth 14 - 18.
- Riders must enter and compete in the same event on the same horse at each show to be eligible to win the Queensland Buckle Series.
- Entry to the series is FREE for EACH horse and rider combination. Only those horse and rider combination that compete in the same class at each nominated show is eligible to win the Queensland Buckle Series.
- 6. Points will be awarded by way of 10pts 1st, 9pts 2nd; 8pts 3rd; 7pts 4th; 6pts 5th; 5pts 6th; 4pts 7th; 3pts 8th; 2pts 9th; 1pt 10th. If there is an equal placing both riders will get the highest points possible for the placing regardless of the toss except where decision is final by way of runoff.
- If there are less than 10 riders then the highest number of points that a rider can obtain is the number of entries in that class. For e.g If only 4 in class – 4pts 1st; 3pts 2nd etc.
- 8. The winner of the Queensland Buckle Series will be the rider/horse combination with highest points from all three shows. In the event of a tie a count back will occur in the following order:-Winner will be decided by most first placings; If equal winner will be decided by most top 3 placings over all 3 shows; If equal- winner will be decided by highest scoring run; If equal-then a coin toss will decide winner unless otherwise agreed by the parties.
- Presentation of the Queensland Buckle Series Buckles will be conducted by relevant delegates on the final night at the QLD State Show.
- 10. In the event that a show is cancelled then the Series will revert to a 2 show series. If more than one show is cancelled the series will be at discretion of relevant committees.
- 11. All decisions made by delegates of QRHA will be deemed final and no correspondence will be entered into.
