#### QRHA Jackpot Show and Clinic

WOW!!! What a show to kick off the year!!! On the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of February 2012 the QRHA commenced their show season with a Jackpot Show and Clinic at the new Queensland State Equestrian Centre (QSEC) in Cabool-ture. With over 100 runs, beautiful clear skies (apart from one hell of a downpour during the early hours of Sunday morning) it was a good way to clear the cob webs and get into the 2012 Reining year.

Our clinic held by much esteemed trainer John WICKS on Saturday was well attended by those lucky enough to book in early. From all reports we could have filled the clinic three times over. So it just goes to show that if you book in early you won't be disappointed. For those that got the opportunity to be a part of the clinic they absolutely had a ball and took away heaps of pointers. We thank John and Angela for their preparation, expertise and for providing this opportunity to our members.

After the clinic, the show began and caught us all by surprise. Expecting a 'smaller' show to get us going we had over 60 runs on the first night as we held our non sanctioned classes. Our members showed they were all keen to get into the swing of things early with some really excellent runs. To kick us off Jorja Ellis had a great run on Bonnie to take out the Short Stirrup event. The Green Rider event proved to be a big hit as it was the biggest class for the night. There are some great prizes and incentives in this Program for beginners and we congratulate Reining Australia for this great initiative for those who are starting out in our sport. And it will also be a very competitive event with Sheridan Deede winning with a great score of 68.5 on her gelding BPS Double Century. Also with a winning score of 68.5 in the Junior Horse was Wayne Williams riding OP Husslers Wimpy Whizz. The next day saw our sanctioned events being conducted and again the numbers were plentiful for those stepping up to the 'one handed' events. The youth showed all the 'oldies' how it was done with Laura Wood on DCS Kentucky Rein running a 68 to take out the Limited Non Pro and Bayley Lowe on Microchip also with a 68 taking out the Rookie (L1) event. Janine Hage had an awesome run on her beautiful mare Whiz n Dunit with a score of 69 to take out Novice Horse Non Pro (L1) and 69.5 was the winning score for Kyley Norman Rookie (L2), Joanna Manz in Limited Open and Darren Simpson in the Intermediate Open. The top score for the show however was Scott Burnett on De Termination with 70.5 to win the Novice Horse Non Pro (L2). Finally it would be remiss of me not to mention the new facility for the QRHA – QSEC. And what a first class facility this is. Firstly the stabling area is 'sensational' featuring huge safe stables for our prized ponies and although there is some 'sawdust work' it is well worth it and not that onerous when you get into it. Secondly the arena is just awesome (in the same sort of AELEC Tamworth style of awesome) and the stopping surface was excellent with some really big stops going down. The State Show in August promises to be an absolute



cracker as there is not a bad seat in the house and a big crowd beckons!! We thank the staff at QSEC for all their friendly assistance and look forward to our upcoming events at this location.

All in all we had a great show and heaps of fun. A big thank you goes out to our judge for the show Mark Cathcart. The QRHA have a strong support base in the local area particularly for those who are just starting out. We encourage all trainers and Reiners to come along and meet some of the new faces in reining.

#### <u>TO QUALIFY FOR ORHA HI-POINT AWARDS</u> <u>RIDERS & OWNERS MUST BE MEMBERS OF ORHA.</u> <u>ORHA NON SANCTIONED EVENTS</u> – MUST BE A MEMBER OF ORHA OR NRHA

BEGINNER RIDER: Restricted to riders who have not won more than 3 Reining events (sanctioned/non sanctioned) as at 1st January 2012

JUNIOR REINING HORSE: For horses five years & under.

SENIOR REINING HORSE: For horses six years and over.

GREEN HORSE: Restricted to horses that have not won more that 3 Reining events as at 1st January 2012.

Western attire and Saddlery not compulsory in these non sanctioned classes however a long sleeved shirt and hat or helmet required (no caps). Riders may use one or two hands on the reins or change from one handed to two handed throughout the performance. Any <u>legal</u> headgear is allowed.

#### GREEN RIDER

Green Rider Level 1 Open to any rider holding valid RA Associate card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points and less than fifty (50) Green Rider points. Green Rider Level 2 Open to any rider holding valid RA Associate card and has less than \$100 in RA lifetime earnings, all categories, has less than twenty five (25) lifetime Youth points and less than 100 (100) Green points. Competitors who are already RA/NRHA members don't have to pay \$30 application fee, just fill out form.

Green Rider Level 1 & 2 Conditions

Green Rider Level 1 and 2 will be run concurrently When exhibitors reach the point level to earn out of the class they will receive an award All riders must pay the Annual fee of \$30 to be in the program (unless you are already RA/NRHA Member) Entry fees are to be determined by show management Show management cannot charge exhibitors a judge's fee Show management can retain any percentage of the entry fee Must use NRHA patterns 1 – 11. However simple lead changes are allowed and the rider may use one (1) or two (2) hands at any time during the pattern.

### Show Information & Conditions

#### Entries to be received by Tuesday 13th March 2012. Entries will be taken on the day.

Owners and riders must be current financial members of the National Reining Horse Association. All horses must be licensed with the NRHA. Any transfers of ownership need to be completed by the NRHA prior to showing. A copy of horse competition license and NRHA membership card must be presented with entry form:

The working order will be drawn and will be as per program with the exception of late entries, which will run first.

The QRHA will retain 50% of the entry fee.

By way of making an entry you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out. The indemnity and consent form accompanying entry form must be completed and signed or entries will not be accepted.

Management reserves the right to alter this program once final entry numbers are known.

- \*\* Limited Open/Rookie Professional will be run concurrently
- \*\* Youth 13 and under & Youth 14-18 will be run concurrently
- \*\* Rookie Level 1 & Level 2 will be run concurrently
- \*\* Non Pro & Prime Time Non Pro will be run concurrently.
- \*\* Intermediate Open and Open will be run concurrently.
- \*\* Novice Horse Open Level 1 & 2— Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 & 2 will be run concurrently

Competitors nominating in both events will only pay one facility fee and one judges fee.






